- Must be enrolled to receive your Wiscard

- o Fall 2019 bus pass pick up begins August 26th, 2019
- o Union South, near Wiscard Office
- o Must be enrolled and show your Wiscard campus ID to obtain a bus pass

- o Check your Wiscmail regularly (campus email)
- o Finalize your enrollment in courses for fall
- o Check your eBill to pay segregated fees each semester
- o Due date of segregated fees is available in the eBill
- Update your mailing address and phone number

✓ SUBMIT FINAL TRANSCRIPTS TO THE GRADUATE SCHOOL ADMISSIONS OFFICE

- If you haven't done so already
- o 217 Bascom Hall, 10am-3pm, Monday-Friday
- o Bachelor's degree must be posted to transcript
- International students may require translation of transcript and/or degree certificate
